Participation

So far in 2025, 300 of our 501 members have participated in at least one of the nine tournaments—a remarkable 67% active participation rate. This is a metric we celebrate every year!

Overall, pace of play has shown noticeable improvement compared to prior years. Most groups finish within the target of 4 hours and 45 minutes, keeping the rounds smooth and enjoyable for everyone. However, a few groups have fallen behind, causing delays. Please continue to practice 'Ready Golf', stay aware of your position on the course, and strive to remain within 15 minutes of the group ahead of you.

Penalties & Rules

To maintain fairness and integrity, tournament rules are enforced consistently across all events. This season, the most common penalties have been for improper drop procedures in penalty areas and slow play penalties. While these situations are never pleasant, consistent enforcement ensures a fair playing field for all. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

As we close out the season, I encourage everyone to review the tournament guidelines and continue building on the positive momentum we have seen this year. With your continued support, we will keep participation high, pace of play steady, and the spirit of fair competition alive.

That means every round played before November 14 must be **posted promptly and accurately** to ensure our Club maintains a fair and competitive playing field for all Members.

Posting your scores **on the same day they are played** is not just a formality, it is a key part of the integrity of our handicap system. Late or missing scores can distort handicap indexes, affect event fairness, and undermine the spirit of competition we all enjoy at Maplewood.

To keep things consistent and transparent, we'll be enforcing the following policy moving forward:

- **First offense:** You'll receive a verbal or email warning reminding you of the importance of timely posting.
- **Second offense:** A penalty will be applied to your handicap to account for the missed or delayed posting.
- **Third offense:** Repeated failure to post scores properly may result in expulsion from the Men's Club after review by the Board.

We all take pride in playing the game the right way—by the rules and with respect for each other. Thank you to everyone who continues to post scores accurately and uphold the integrity of our competitions.

Let's finish the season strong and enjoy these last few weeks of great golf before the winter break.

Course Improvements: Tee Deck Re-Leveling

Our maintenance team will begin re-leveling select tee decks in phases this season. What to expect (temporary adjustments):

- Tee blocks will shift while a tee deck is shut down for turf grow-in.
 - o Blue + White play from the white deck
 - Red joins Yellow
- Expected tee deck closures. Blue #1, 16 &18 -/ White #15 / Red -#1, 2, 7, 16 &18

Thanks for your patience while we make Maplewood even better.

We would also like to remind all customers that the Riverrock Grill is here for your food and beverage needs and the WA liquor control board laws prohibit alcohol from being brought onto the golf course.

2026 fees will see a price increase. 2026 prices will begin in April. Please see the attached fee schedule that was approved for the 2025-2026 budget years.

Spring Aerification is scheduled to begin Monday, March 16th or 23rd.
